

Introduction

This report analyzes classroom and lab utilization for the fall 2000 semester. "Utilization" refers to the number of instructional hours scheduled per week in designated classrooms (room type 110 in the SWT Rooms Inventory) or class labs (room type 210). The total instructional hours for each classroom or lab are then compared with the "utilization standard," as defined by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (CB).

In 1997, the CB began calculating classroom and lab utilization using a 50-minute hour, therefore 50-minute hours are used in this report. Currently, the CB utilization standard for classrooms is 38 hours per week. The lab utilization standard is 25 hours per week.

This report focuses on **room type only**. No distinction is made between lecture or lab sections. This means that the 140 lab sections (411 hours) taught in designated classrooms apply only to the classroom totals. The 179 class sections (818 hours) taught in designated class labs apply only to the lab totals.

During the Fall 2000 semester, 10,178 instructional hours were scheduled at SWT. For this report 547 course sections (1927.6 hours) that were taught in rooms not designated as classrooms or class labs have been removed. See the following table for details.

As requested at the November 29, 2000 EQPC meeting, the VPFSS office shared this information with the Deans to determine if any of the above mentioned were improperly coded. (Especially those hours offered in the lab service, special class labs and research labs). Some corrections were made to the inventory and sent to the Coordinating Board.

In addition, all but one course section that was scheduled in a "stacked" room have been removed from the totals. In a stacked room 2 or more courses are taught at the same time. The total deduction for stacked rooms is 613 instructional hours.

With the above-mentioned deductions, the 10,178 total instructional hours was reduced to 7637.4 hours. More specifically, the tables are based on 6489.9 scheduled instructional hours in 167 designated classrooms and 1147.5 instructional hours scheduled in 46 designated class labs.
